Today's lessons:

- 2 Samuel 23:1-7 This song of King David is a kind of testament, reminding his successors of the covenant God made with David and his family.
- Psalms 132:1-12 (13-18) A song about David: how he wanted to build a house for the Lord (the Temple), and how then the Lord built a house for David (the Davidic dynasty).
- Revelation 1:4b-8 Revelation, the last book of the Bible, that deals with the coming of God's kingdom at the end of times, begins with celebrating God as 'Alpha' and 'Omega', meaning the beginning and the end of everything.
- John 18:33-37 When the Governor Pontius Pilate asks Jesus about his kingdom, Jesus gives an answer that sounds evasive at first, but in the end turns out to be nothing but the truth.

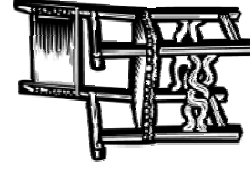
Revelation on Paper
